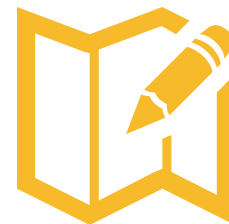


# Solano County CoC System Performance Measures



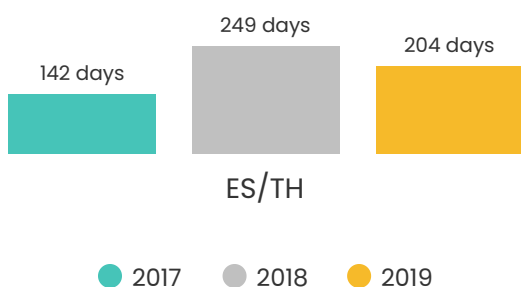
This document provides general information on the Vallejo/Solano County CoC's System Performance Measures. The agency data comes from the CoC's HMIS and was submitted in HDX. The data labeled "2017" covers October 1, 2016 to September 30, 2017. The data labeled "2018" covers October 1, 2017 to September 30, 2018. The data labeled "2019" covers October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019.

Using these metrics to better understand program outcomes supports strengthening the performance of the system as a whole

## Average Length of Time Homeless

Average length of time homeless measures the average number of days a participant is enrolled in an Emergency Shelter (ES) or Transitional Housing (TH) program. This measure shows how quickly the system of care resolves homelessness for people in the community. *HUD System Performance Measure 1.*

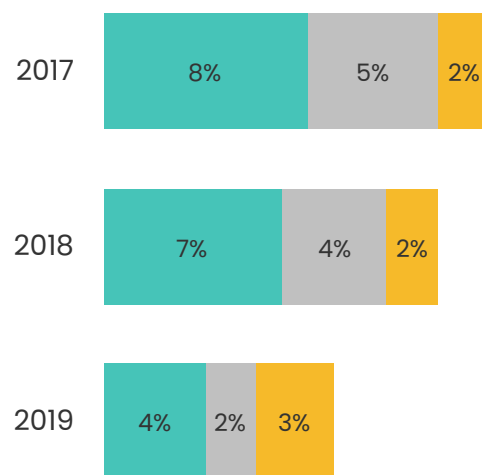


## Returns to Homelessness

This measures the extent to which persons who exit homelessness to permanent housing (PH) return to homelessness within less than 6 months, 6 to 12 months, or 24 months.

According to SPM data, the total percentages of participants who exited to PH and returned to homelessness within two years was 15% in 2017, 13% in 2018, and 9% in 2019.

## Increases in Income

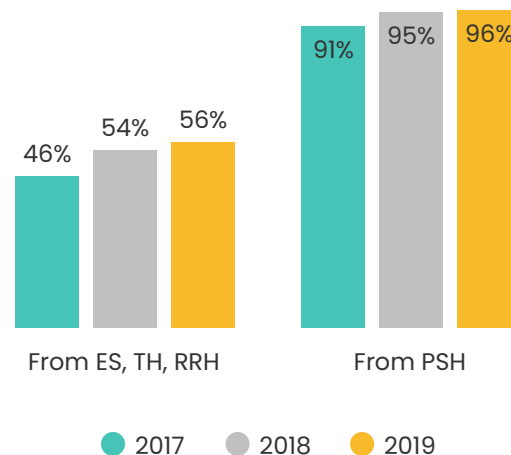
Increases in employment and non-employment income occur between clients' enrollment and exit (Leavers) or follow-up assessment (Stayers). *HUD System Performance Measure 4.*

Year	Category	% Increased Total Income
2017	Leaver	11% (7 out of 62)
2018	Leaver	38% (3 out of 8)
2019	Leaver	21% (7 out of 33)
2017	Stayer	23% (11 out of 48)
2018	Stayer	8% (1 out of 12)
2019	Stayer	14% (5 out of 35)

## Exits to Permanent Housing

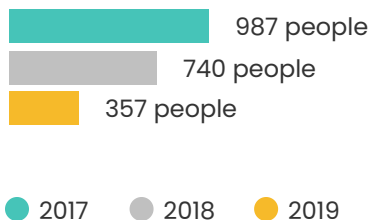
This measure identifies the percentage of all persons served during the reporting period who exited to permanent housing destinations or remained in permanent housing.

## First-Time Homeless

Measures the number of persons who become homeless for the first time. This measure tells us about the success of the system of care at preventing homelessness before it begins.
